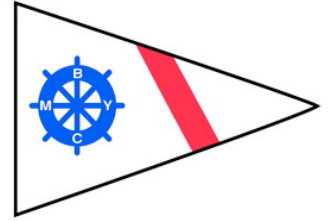

### 2012 Spring Sail Regatta on Lake Washington



#### Invitation

Dear Sailor,

Meydenbauer Bay Yacht Club (MBYC) invites you to participate in the 2012 Spring Sail Regatta on Lake Washington. The dates are Saturday, March 24th and Sunday, March 25th, 2012.

The format will be, three round-the-buoy races on Saturday, and one round-the-buoy race on Sunday. There will be a minimum of two divisions, flying sail and non-flying sails. The racing area will be on Lake Washington between the Evergreen Point Bridge to the north, the Mercer Island Floating Bridge / I-90 to the south, Seattle to the West, and Bellevue to the east.

On Saturday evening, a no-host bar in the Wheel House opens at 5:30 PM with Hors d'oeuvre. Dinner will be served at 7:00 PM in the clubhouse dining room for all sailors and friends with reservations. All sailors are invited to attend the 5:30 event.

Awards for the Winter 2012 Sailing Series and for the Spring 2012 Sail Regatta will be presented in the MBYC clubhouse at the completion of the Sunday race. A no-host bar will be open and light Hors d'oeuvre will be served in the Wheel House.

Free moorage will be available to boats requesting space on the entry form on a "first come, space available basis". Please do not moor at the end of dock 1 (east dock), as it is reserved for private club moorage or at dock 3 (west dock), as it is reserved for the use of the pump out facilities.

If you do not have a current PHRF rating, it will be your responsibility to contact Doug Penny (206-786-3684, voice mail does not qualify) to establish a rating by March 17, 2012.

If you have a friend who enjoys racing, invite them to participate.

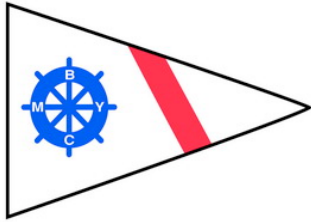
Thanks again for your past and future support of the annual regattas on Lake Washington. We hope you and your crew will join us for some fun on the lake .

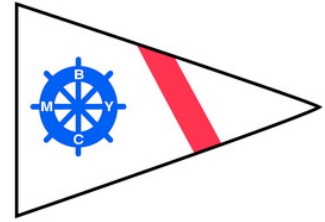

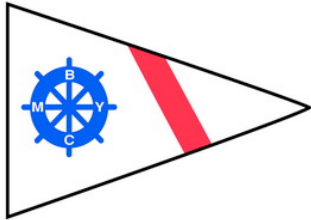
\*\* The Spring Regatta Entry Fee is \$30.00 per boat and covers one or both days of racing.

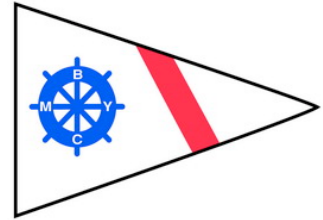

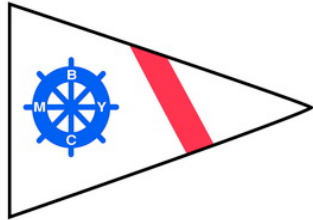

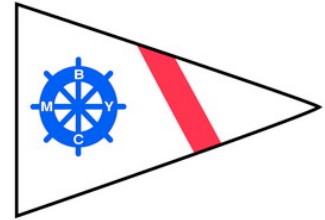

## Notice of Race

EVENT: Meydenbauer Bay Yacht Club 2012 Spring Sail Regatta on Lake Washington.

DATES: Saturday, March 24, 2012 - Three races.  
Sunday, March 25, 2012 - One race

START TIMES: Race start times for Saturday are as follows:

Race No. 1:	Warning for first class:	10:00 hrs.
	Start:	10:05 hrs.

Each succeeding class will start on 5-minute intervals.

Race Numbers 2 & 3 will have their warning signal approximately 5 minutes after the finish of the last boat of the preceding race. No races will be started after 1430 hrs.

Race start time for Sunday is as follows:

One Race:	Warning for first class:	10:00 hrs.
	Start:	10:05 hrs.

PLACE: The racing area will be on Lake Washington between the Evergreen Point Bridge to the north, the Mercer Island Floating Bridge / I-90 to the south, Seattle to the west, and Bellevue to the east.

STARTING AND FINISHING AREA: The starting and finishing area will be in the vicinity of the Medina City Hall and the north end of Mercer Island. The start and finish line will be between the Race Committee Boat and a red / orange mark.

THE COURSE: Every effort will be made to establish a windward / leeward or a windward / gybing / leeward type of triangular course using orange or yellow inflatable triangular marks. The course will be announced by the Committee Boat at the start. The Committee Boat can be identified by the R.C. flag and the MBYC Club burgee.

RULES: Governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) for 2009-2012 Edition, International Sailing Federation, and as modified by the General Sailing Instructions. In case of conflict, the Sailing Instructions will govern. The racing will be conducted under PHRF ratings and a boat may enter in either the flying sails or non-flying sails category. Those electing to participate in the flying sails category must have a valid PHRF rating. Those participating in the non-flying sails category may have a valid PHRF rating or may apply to MBYC, which will assign handicap ratings only for applications received prior to March 17, 2012. The event is restricted to monohull boats.

**SAFETY REGULATIONS:** All boats shall comply with the PIYA Category IV requirements.

**CLASSES:** Boats will be grouped for most effective level classes. One-design starts will be used where possible (five boat minimum). The Race Committee reserves the right to change the class breakdown based on entries. All entries will be posted by class on the bulletin board located on Dock No. 3 (west end) at MBYC by 1800 hours on the day of the race. The committee boat can advise boats of classes.

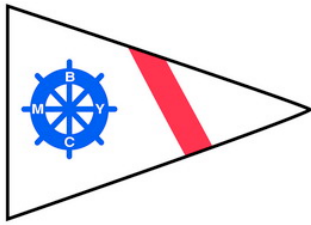
**SCORING:** The Low Point System, Rule A2, will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if 4 races have been completed. Four (4) races are scheduled, of which 1 race shall be completed to constitute a series. Points shall be scored for each yacht recorded on the official race results as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place, 1 point; 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 2 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place, 3 points; etc.
- Yachts recorded as DNF shall score N+1 points, where N equals the number of yachts finishing that race.
- Yachts recorded as DSQ shall score N+2 points, where N equals the number of yachts starting that race.
- Yachts starting any valid race series, but not starting a given race, will be recorded as DNS for each race missed. Each DNS will be scored as N+1, where N equals the number of yachts starting that race.

**TROPHIES:** Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places will be awarded to the respective yachts in their class. Trophies will be awarded after the Regatta on Sunday afternoon, March 25, 2012, at the Clubhouse. Only the first place trophy will be awarded for classes with an average of less than five starters.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$30.00 covers both days of racing.

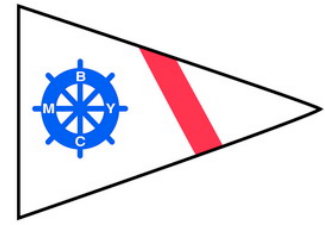

## 2012 Sailboat Racing

### Waiver, Release and Indemnification

I acknowledge that I have sole responsibility for the safety of my crew and yacht. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.

MBYC Race Committee, and/or any other sponsor of the MBYC 2012 Sailing Regattas are in no way to be held responsible for accidents, damage, injury, or death to persons, property or to yachts, crew or guest arising from any cause prior to, during or related to any race or activities of the 2012 Sailing Regattas. Each Skipper and his crew must evaluate weather and sea conditions and each participant is responsible for determining whether it is safe for him to participate. The responsibility of wearing a life jacket rests upon the Skipper and his crew. If a Committee vessel and/or personnel provide assistance, it is at the risk of the participants.

I hereby agree to all of the Conditions for the 2012 MBYC Sail Regattas and shall inform each member of my crew of these Conditions. I hereby warrant that my yacht will be outfitted, equipped and handled in accordance with these Conditions; that she will have all of the required equipment aboard; that she is seaworthy in hull, rig and gear; that she will be completely manned. I agree that the rating with my entry as filed with the Committee will be the applicable rating for the yacht at the time she starts the race.

In consideration of your accepting my Entry for the MBYC 2012 Sailing Regattas, I do for myself, my executors, my administrators and assigns waive and release any and all claims that I have against MBYC, Race Committee, and any other sponsor, officers, directors, members, committeemen, volunteers, employees and agents, or any one or more of them or their executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, or assigns, including pre-start and post-finish operations and shore activities together with any costs and expenses including attorney's fees that may be incurred as a result of any such claim whether valid or not, and I do hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless each of them against any such claims that any officer, member of my crew or one of my guests (or the executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, and assigns of any of them) may have or assert together with any cost and expenses including attorney's fees with respect thereto.
