## NOTICE OF RACE

- EVENT:** Meydenbauer Bay Yacht Club Spring Sail Regatta on Lake Washington.
- DATES:** Saturday, March 29, 2008- Three races.  
Sunday, March 30, 2008 - One race.
- PLACE:** The starting line will be in the center of Lake Washington midway between the two floating bridges.
- RULES:** Governed by the 2005-2008 The Racing Rules of Sailing, and as modified by the Sailing Instructions. In case of conflict, the Sailing Instructions will govern. The racing will be conducted under PHRF ratings and a boat may enter in either the flying sails or non-flying sails category. Those electing to participate in the flying sails category must have a valid PHRF rating. Those participating in the non-flying sails category may have a valid PHRF rating or may apply to MBYC, which will assign handicap ratings only for applications received prior to March 22, 2008. The event is restricted to monohull boats.
- CLASSES:** Boats will be grouped for most effective level classes. One-design starts will be used where possible (five boat minimum). The Race Committee reserves the right to change the class breakdown based on entries. All entries will be posted by class on the bulletin board located on Dock No. 3 (west end) at MBYC. The committee boat will advise boats of classes.
- COURSES:** To be announced by the Committee Boat at the start. The Committee Boat can be identified by the R.C. flag and the MBYC Club burgee.
- SCHEDULE:** The approximate starting times for each race are:

- TROPHIES:** Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places will be awarded to the respective yachts in their class. Trophies will be awarded Sunday afternoon, March 30, 2008, at the Clubhouse.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$25.00 covers both days of racing.
- RELATED EVENTS:** Saturday night, MBYC will have a dinner for all sailors, crews, and friends. A buffet style dinner for \$15.00 will be served in the Clubhouse at 6:30 p.m. The bar will be open to racers on Saturday evening at 5:30 p.m. and Sunday afternoon for the trophy presentation. Space is limited to 180 reservations on Saturday.
- MOORAGE:** Free moorage at MBYC will be available to all boats requesting space on the entry form.
- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Will be mailed out immediately upon receipt of registration fee.
